**WHAT IS THIS ABOUT?**

A proposed settlement has been reached in a lawsuit concerning rates for electricity charged by Electricity Maine, LLC.

**WHO'S INCLUDED?**

The Settlement includes all residential and small business consumers who purchased electricity from Electricity Maine, LLC at any time from January 1, 2011, through and including November 30, 2019. Please see the Settlement Website [www.VeilleuxSettlement.com](http://www.VeilleuxSettlement.com), for information on certain exclusions.

**WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?**

The Settlement provides up to a maximum fund of \$14,000,000 for payments to Settlement Class Members who submit Valid Claims. If you timely submit a Valid Claim Form, you may be eligible for a benefit, in an amount equal to \$0.0023565 per kilowatt hour purchased by you at any time from January 1, 2011 through and including November 30, 2019. In no event shall the Calculated Payment paid to any Claimant be less than \$2.50. Depending on how many claims are filed, your benefit may be reduced.

**CLAIM FORM DEADLINE**

Claims must be received by Thursday, September 10, 2020, in order to seek to participate in the Settlement.

## **YOUR OTHER OPTIONS:**

If you do not Opt-Out in writing by Thursday, September 10, 2020, you will be bound by the terms of the Settlement as well as all orders of the Court, and will have no right to sue later for the claims released by the Settlement. If you want to participate in the Settlement, but object to its terms, you may file an Objection by Thursday, September 10, 2020. The Court will schedule and hold a hearing to consider whether to approve the Settlement and whether to award up to \$3,920,000 in Attorney's Fee and Expenses to Class Counsel and \$5,000 to each Named Plaintiff. You may attend this hearing, but you do not have to. ## **WHO REPRESENTS ME?**

The Court appointed Thomas Hallett and Benjamin Donahue of Hallett, Whipple Weyrens, P.A. and Robert Cummins of The Cummins Law Firm, P.A. as Class Counsel, whom you do not have to pay. If you want your own lawyer, you may hire one at your expense.
